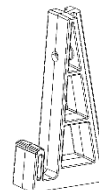

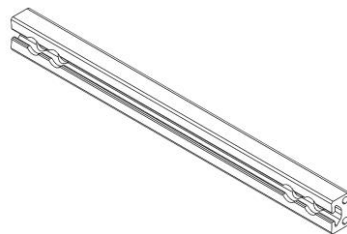

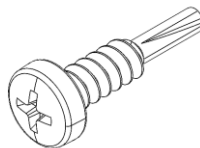

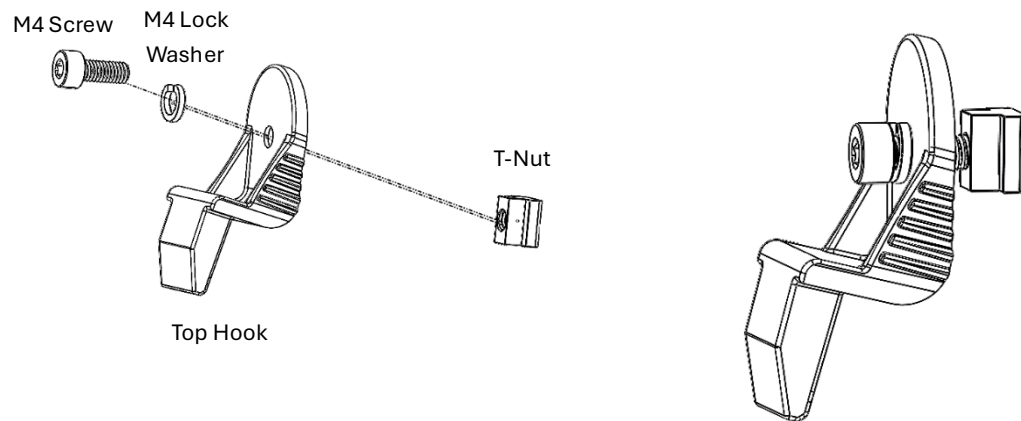

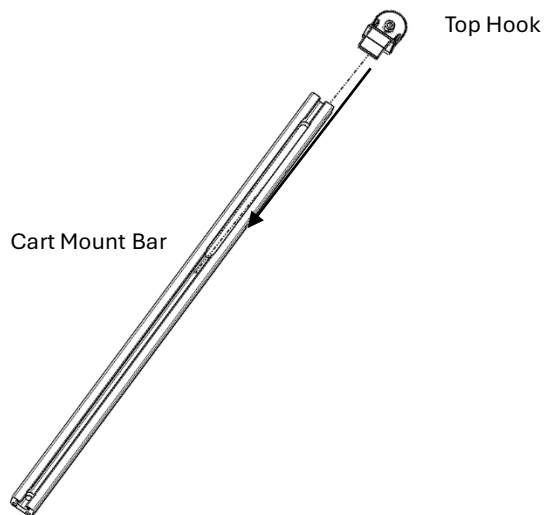
Installation Instructions

1. Preparation:

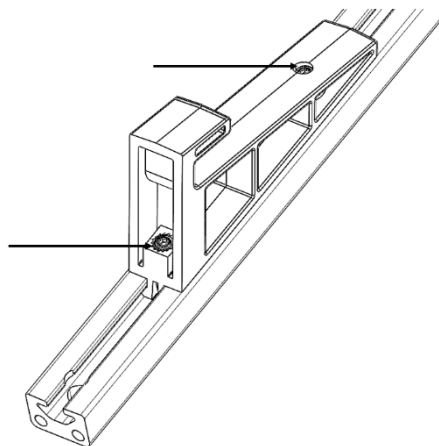
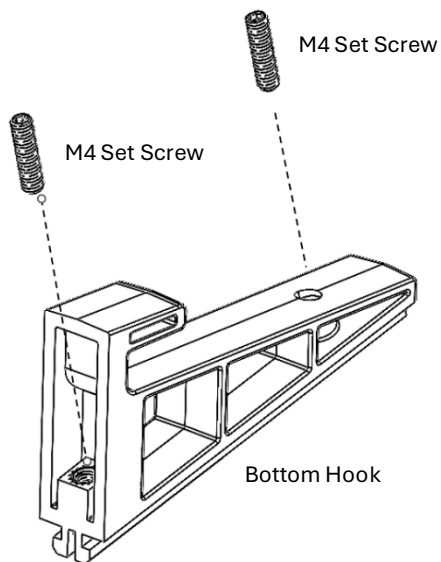
- Remove all components from packaging
- Ensure your golf cart windshield frame is clean and dry
- Combine the **Top Hook**, **M4 Screw**, **M4 Lock Washer** and **T-Nut**. Screw it together as shown in the picture below.



- Locate two (2) **Cart Mount Bars**, insert the previous assembly (**Top Hook**, **M4 Screw**, **M4 Lock Washer** and **T Nut**) to the channel, position them in the center channel bar in preparation for the installation.



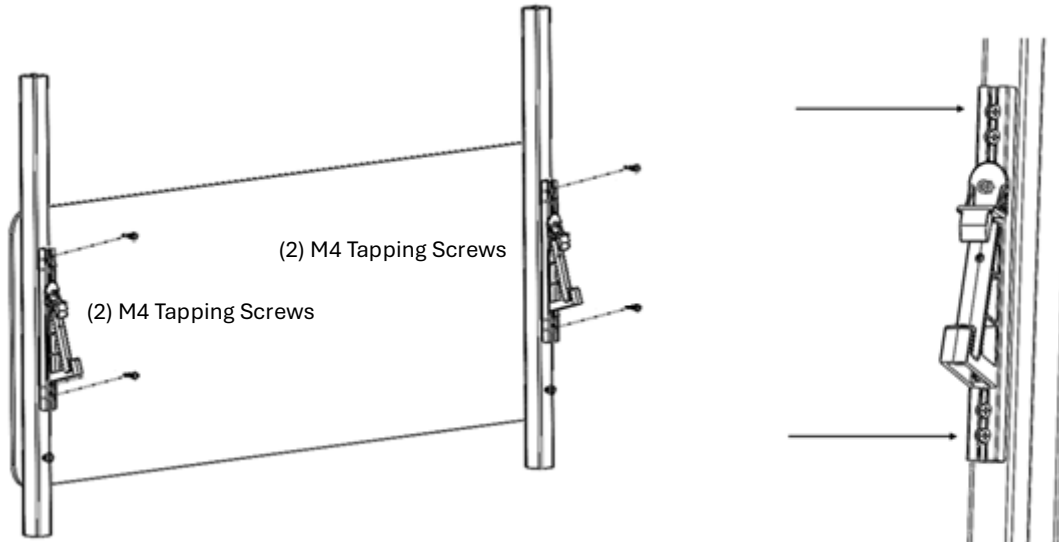
- Locate two (2) **Bottom Hooks** and place (2) **M4 Set Screws** into each as shown in the picture below. Install them at the desired location and height on the **Cart Mount Bars**.
Position them at the bottom of the channel bar in preparation for the installation.
- Tighten using the **2mm Hex Key**.



2. Installation

VERSION A: Cart Mount Bar with M4 Tapping Screws Only (Most Secure and Universal)

- Add the **Cart Mount Bar** onto the golf cart **pre-drilling holes using a 1/8th drill bit in the desired location** and screwing two (2) **M4 Tapping Screws** into each side at the desired height. Ensure you have enough room for adding the accessories after the installation and that they will not obstruct vision or the golf cart dash.

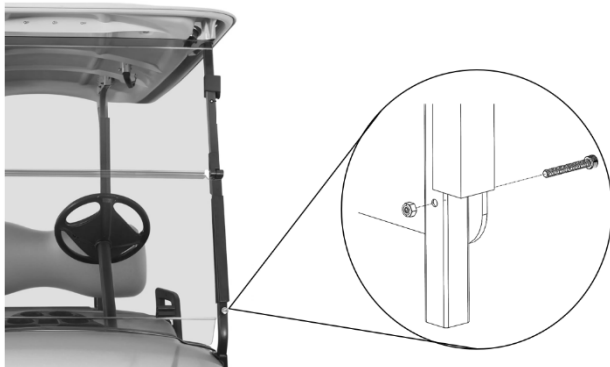


VERSION B: Cart Mount Bar with M6 Screws and C-Clips (Non-Drill Option)

Notes: Refer to **VERSION A** if your golf cart windshield is held on by a “windshield plastic sleeve”

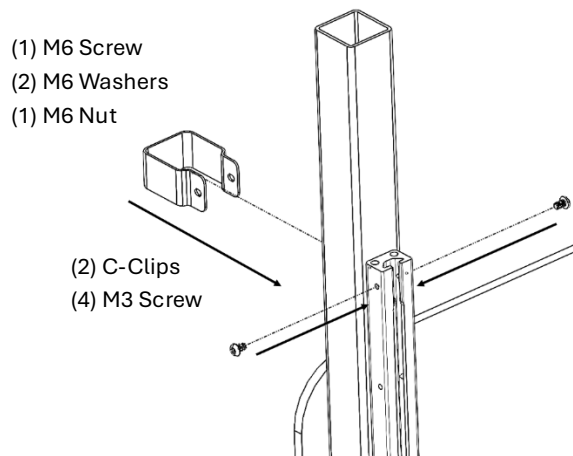
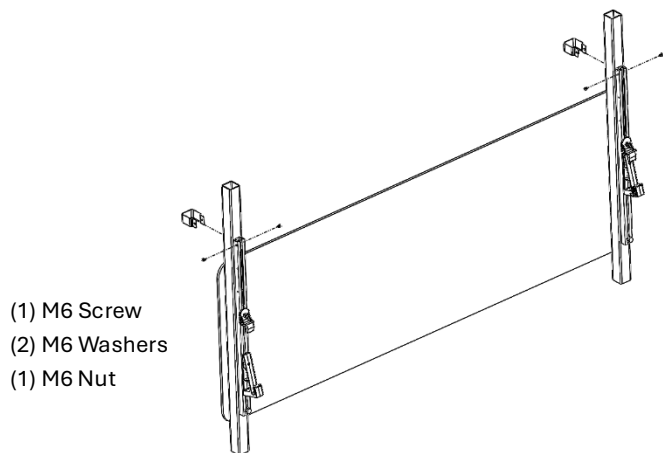
Parts not available until Q3 2025

- Unscrew the existing bolts that hold the windshield to the golf cart frame (note: depending on the golf cart windshield brand, it may require additional tools not included).

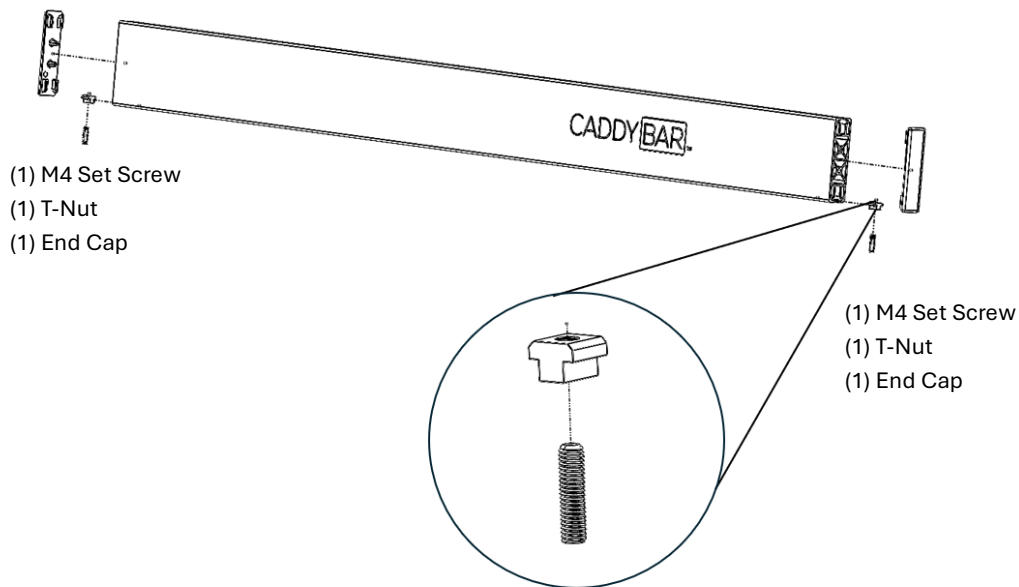




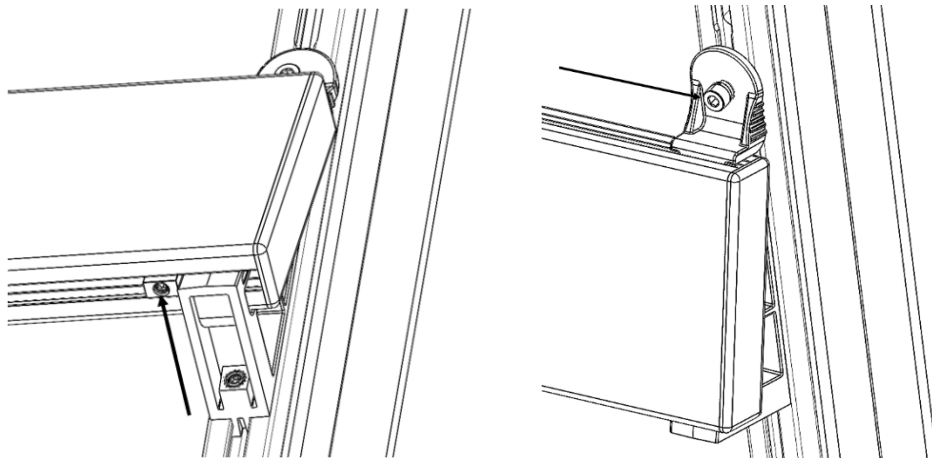
- Install 3" **M6 Screws, M6 Washers and M6 Nuts** at the bottom of each **Cart Mount Bar**.
- Locate two (2) **C-Clips** and secure them in place at the top of each **Cart Mount Bar** with a **3mm Hex Key**.



- Locate the **CADDYBAR**. Add **M4 Set Screws** to **T-Nuts** and slide into the bottom channel. Add **End Caps** to each side. (**IMPORANT NOTE: T-Nuts with M4 Set Screws MUST be added before the end caps**).



- Secure **CADDYBAR** on to **Bottom Hooks**. Slide **T-Nuts** with **M4 Set Screws** up against the **Bottom Hooks** on each side and tighten to lock into place using a **2mm Hex Key**. Slide the **Top Hook** down into the top channel of the **CADDYBAR** and lock into place by tightening the **M4 Screws** on each side using a **3mm Hex Key**.





3. Final Check:

- Test the installation by gently pulling on the bar to ensure it is firmly attached
- Confirm that the CADDYBAR™ is secure (if not revisit instructions) and add desired accessories
- Add accessories to the bar by inserting top clip into top channel first and push down and in to secure
- To remove an accessory from the bar, locate the bottom tab on secured clip and pull towards you

Usage Guidelines

- What to Carry: Use the CADDYBAR™ to hold lightweight personal items
- Weight Limit: Do not exceed the maximum load of 30 lbs.
- Securing Items: Ensure all items are properly placed and secured before moving the cart

Maintenance and Care

- Clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that may damage the finish
- Store in a dry and protected area when not in use to avoid damage
